RECYCLING CONTAINERS **FOR GLASS**



PAPER COLLECTION



In the Bio bin please put:

- · grass, hedge and tree cuttings
- garden waste
- leaves
- flowers, plants and soil
- windfall fruit
- food leftovers
- egg shells
- fruit and vegetable peelings
- rotten food (without packaging!)
- coffee filters and pads
- tea bags
- kitchen roll, greaseproof paper
- paper serviettes and tissues

Please wrap vour bio-degradable waste in old newspaper or paper bags to stop it freezing, and to prevent the spread of odours and maggots



Plastic bags are not to be used. even if they are labelled or considered to be biodegradable or environmentally friendly!

No animal straw or cat litter!

In the general waste bin please put:

- · ash, cigarette ash and filters
- indoor and outdoor sweepings
- vacuum bags
- wallpaper
- · carpet cuttings and carpet tiles
- porcelain, ceramics (small amounts)
- leather and rubber material cuttings
- standard light bulbs, candles
- used marker pens, ink cartridges and inkpads
- music/video cassettes, photos, slides and negatives (small amounts)
- files and folders
- cotton wool balls, cotton buds
- · sanitary pads and tampons
- · cosmetic tissues, wipes nappies
- animal straw and cat litter
- · small plastic items eg. toys, toothbrushes, plastic bowls
- rags, material, shoes
- cleaning rags (not oil-stained!)



No food or garden waste! No packaging, paper or cardboard! No large pieces of wood or metal! No plaster, concrete, stones or tiles! No old medicines or tablets! No electrical, solar or battery-driven appliances

In the yellow sack/bin please put recyclable packaging, such as:

- milk/drink cartons, Tetrapacks
- plastic wrapping and bags
- margarine/yoghurt pots
- fruit and vegetable trays or nets
- plastic plant pots
- detergent, cleaning product bottles
- shampoo, body care product bottles
- polystyrene packaging
- sweet or snack packaging
- vacuum packaging (eg. coffee)

and metal packaging, such as:

- aluminium trays and foil
- aluminium lids (eg. yoghurt)
- food/drink tins and cans
- beer bottle tops
- screw tops or lids



No toys!

No household objects or building materials made of plastic!

- glass jars
- · other small glass containers

sorted by colour:

- white/clear glass
- brown glass
- green (and blue) glass

In the paper collection please put:

- newspapers and magazines
- catalogues and calendars
- writing paper and envelopes
- books
- cardboard and paper packaging
- paper tissues
- pamphlets, brochures and printed advertisements



STOP

No lids! No earthenware! No porcelain, plates, cups etc.! No leaded glass! No windows, mirrors or safety glass! No car windows! No vases, serving dishes, coffee jugs or glass lampshades! No household or car light bulbs!
